PPD Thesis Prize

(proposal draft)

A thesis prize should be set up and awarded yearly at the CAP Congress to the particle physics student having submitted the best Ph.D. thesis in the previous calendar year.

Goals

- Encourage students in the field
- Promote awareness of their work
- Further advertise activities of the groups to the community

Rules

- 1) The thesis must have been submitted at the local university during the previous calendar year
- 2) The date is the official university internal submission date .. (please somebody remind me of the best date and the proper wording for this!)
- 3) Submission to the PPD jury should occur by the end of February
- 4) A letter by the thesis supervisor should accompany the submission.
- 5) There should be at least five (5) submitted thesis for the prize to be given.
- 6) Four (4) copies of the thesis should be submitted. (allow e-copy?)
- 7) The PPD jury of four (4) should be formed by the current Chair and the previous 3 Chairs, and be led by the current Past-Chair.
- 8) The prize (400\$?) would be awarded at the following Annual Meeting of the Division at the CAP Congress.
- 9) The winner should agree to attend the Congress if selected.
- 10) In case of a draw, the prize could be split at most in two.

Implementation Steps

- Check with CAP that this is possible and allowed (done)
- Circulate the draft among the members (September 2001)
- The PPD jury should collect all comments and corrections, and finalize this document (November 2001)
- The PPD jury should advertize to all members of the PPD and IPP communities (December 2001)
