Name Badges

SPECIAL EVENTS – IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO NOTE

Welcome BBQ and Herzberg Public Lecture - Monday, June 15

If you pre-registered for the **welcome BBQ**, you will find a ticket for the event in your registration package. The ticket must be turned in to obtain your meal and soft drink. Service will begin at 5:15 pm. At 5:45 pm, if there is still food available following service of all pre-registered delegates, plates will be made available to delegates who did not pre-register.

Special general admission tickets are required to attend the **Herzberg Public lecture**. If you pre-registered for this event, you should find an event ticket attached to your sheet of tickets in your registration package. Seating is limited. For any delegate who did not pre-register but would like to attend, please see the CAP desk at registration to sign up for the event and obtain a ticket, if available.

Because of licensing restrictions, the CAP is unable to provide beer or wine at the Welcome BBQ this year. We are, therefore, providing a complimentary beer, wine, or soft drink at the reception following the Herzberg public lecture. Drink tickets have been provided to delegates who have **pre-registered** for the Monday Herzberg lecture and will be provided to any delegate who obtains a ticket for the lecture from the CAP desk.

If you see the Herzberg lecture in your sheet of tickets but do not have the general admission ticket or the drink ticket for that event is missing (marked "R"), please bring your ticket sheet (intact) to the CAP desk in the registration area to obtain your event/drink ticket.

Poster Session - Wednesday, June 17

If you pre-registered for the **poster session**, you will find this event listed on the sheet in your registration package, along with a ticket (marked "P-A") which can be turned in for a complimentary glass of beer, wine, or soft drink. Light snacks (hors d'oeuvres) will be provided at this event. A cash bar will be available as well. If you did not pre-register but plan to attend, please see the CAP desk where you can add your name to the list of attendees and obtain a drink ticket for the event.

Recognition Reception at Art Gallery of Alberta – Thursday – June 18

Delegates who purchased a ticket for the Recognition Reception will find their ticket on the sheet in their registration package, along with a ticket (marked "AGA") which can be turned in for a complimentary glass of beer, wine, or soft drink. A cash bar will be available as well. If you selected a vegetarian meal at the AGA, please ensure that your name badge includes a bright green circle. If not, please bring your ticket with your meal choice and your name badge to the CAP desk at reception to have this corrected.

Getting there - Delegates attending the reception are encouraged to take the LRT which will take them directly to the Art Gallery. The directions for doing so, as well as a list of items to bring with you, are included on a separate sheet in your registration package.

If you have not purchased a ticket but would like to attend the recognition reception, please see the CAP desk where you can add your name to a waiting list in case tickets become available.

Division Business Meetings during Congress

Division business meetings are open to all Congress delegates interested in attending, but only members of the Division can vote. Delegates who pre-registered for a meeting will find a ticket on the sheet in their registration package which can be turned in for their lunch box. The student volunteer who will be distributing the lunches in the meeting room will have a list of lunch orders in case you forget your ticket. If you didn't pre-register, you can pick up a lunch at one of the food outlets and join the meeting.
