**Dr. David Hobill**

David Hobill obtained his Ph.D. in physics at the University of Victoria in 1980. After Postdoctoral Positions at the Poincare Institute in Paris, the Max Planck Institute in Munich and Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken N.J. he became a senior research scientist at the National Center for Supercomputing Applications at the University of Illinois where he was the head of the numerical relativity group. Since 1991 he has been at the University of Calgary where his research has been focused mainly on topics related to general relativity, (black holes, gravitational waves, cosmology, gravitational lensing, and exact solutions) and nonlinear dynamical systems. More recently his interests have expanded to quantum information theory, plasma physics and even the development of models for biological growth.
